HOW GIFT AID WORKS

If you pay tax, Gift Aid is a scheme by which you can give a sum of money to a charity and the charity can reclaim from the Inland Revenue basic-rate tax on your gift. This increases the value of your gift to the charity. For example, if you give £50 using Gift Aid in the 2008/2009 tax year, that gift is worth over £64 to the charity. Subject to a few rules, you can give any amount, large or small, regular or one-off.

If you are a higher-rate taxpayer, you can claim relief on the difference between the basic rate and higher rate of tax.

If you are not a taxpayer, you should not use Gift Aid. Please note also that companies cannot use the Gift Aid scheme.
